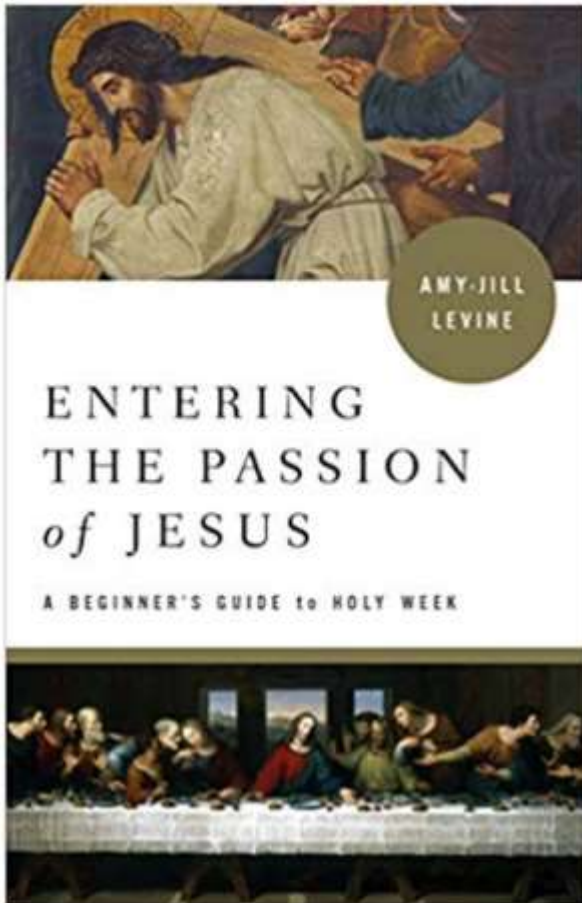

## Entering the Passion of Jesus A Beginners Guide to Holy Week

by Dr. Amy-Jill Levine

In *Entering the Passion of Jesus: A Beginner's Guide to Holy Week*, author, professor, and biblical scholar Amy-Jill Levine explores the biblical texts surrounding the Passion story. She shows us how the text raises ethical and spiritual questions for the reader, and how we all face risk in our Christian experience.

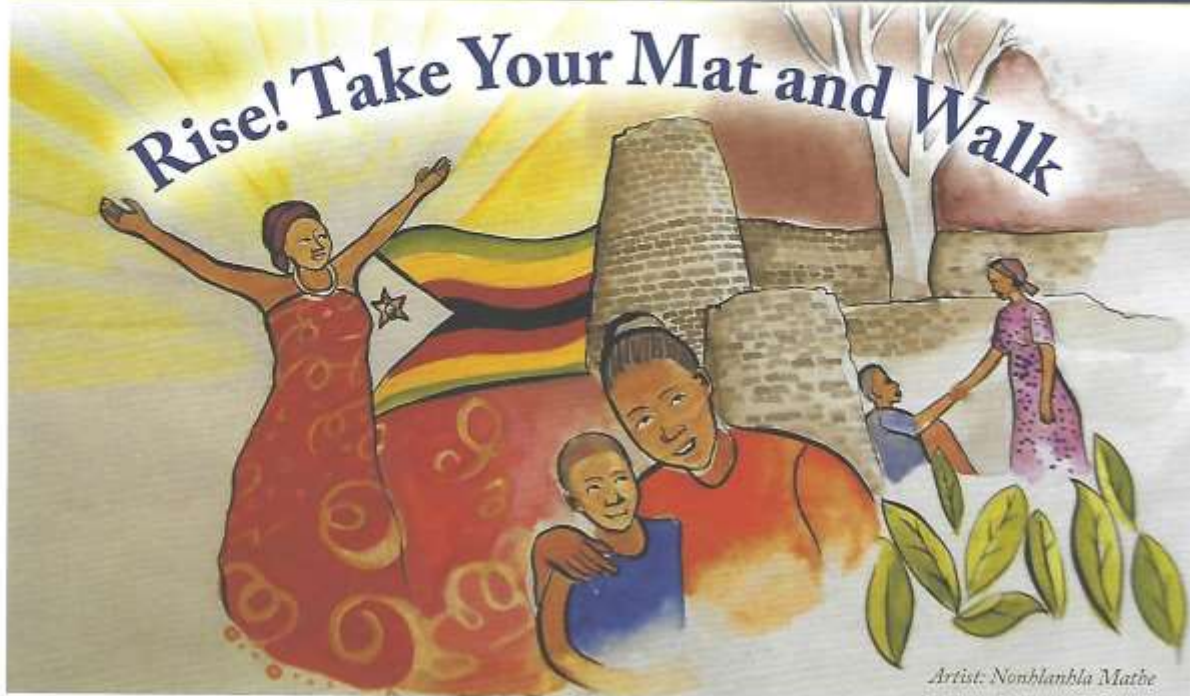

**Bishop Riscylla** grew up on a family-farm in rural Muskoka. Her maternal Grandfather went to an Indian Residential School in Manitoba, and her mother, Ruth Wagner, is a Senator for the Metis Nation of Ontario. Inspired by Desmond Tutu and the South African Truth and Reconciliation Commission, Bishop Riscylla attended the seven national events of the Canadian TRC, on personal pilgrimage and as an Ambassador of Reconciliation for the Diocese of Toronto. Following the TRC she chaired the Primate's Commission on Discovery, Reconciliation and Justice from 2013-2019 and now serves on the National Church's Jubilee Commission.

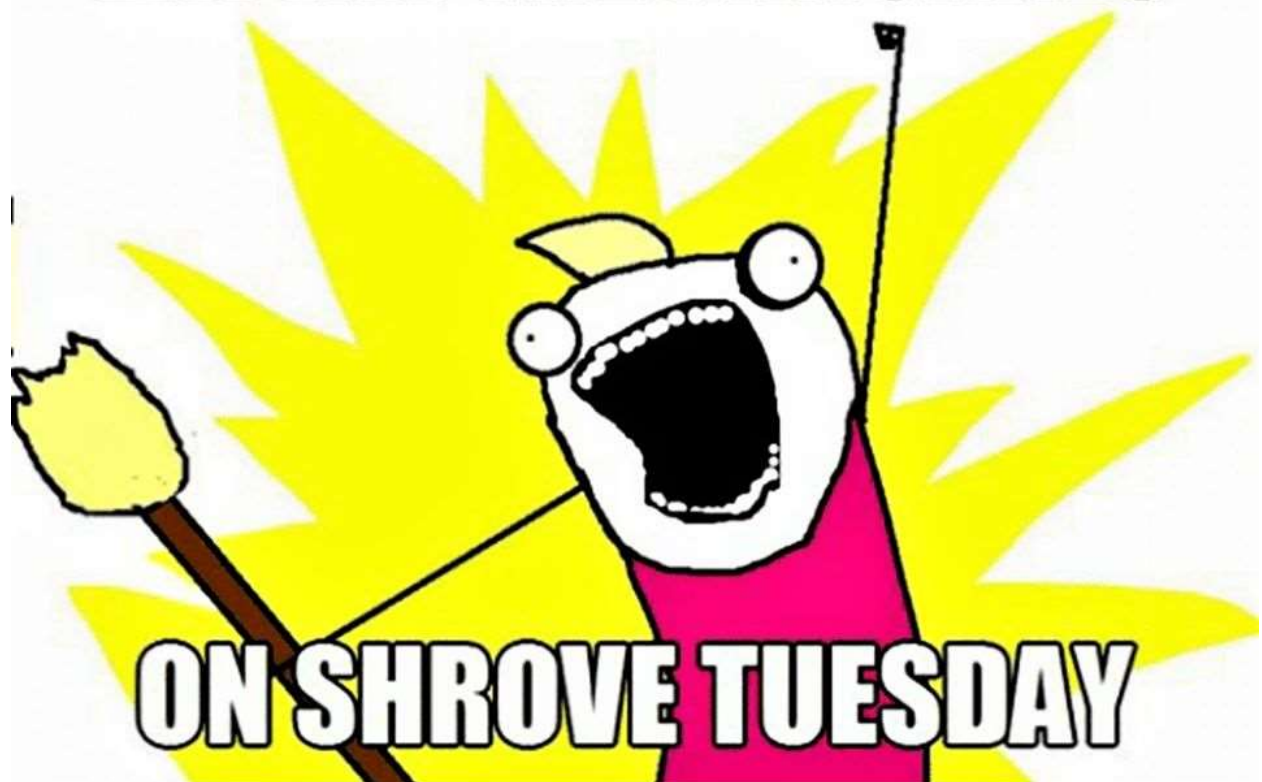
