

In 2015, as part of its commitment to support the findings of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission, PWRDF developed the resource: Mapping the Ground We Stand On. Using PowerPoint, videos, small group discussion, talking circle and more, this workshop - also known as the Mapping Exercise - invites participants to explore Indigenous presence on the map of Turtle Island/Canada, the history of settler arrival, and how each fits into ongoing narratives. The concepts of Doctrine of Discovery, terra nullius, Indigenous Knowledge and Ways of Knowing are also explored. Listening, understanding and reflecting enable us to imagine meaningful next steps for our personal and collective journeys - church, family, community, that will foster respectful, just, and healing relationships for all peoples - Indigenous and settler.



## Sharing the Christmas Spirit




Caring for seafarers around the world


