When? Saturday, June 15—the march starts at 11am, and we will be at Hillcrest Park starting at about10am



Our busy spring continues. In May we set a couple of records, for the # days staffed in a month by volunteers at 26 and the # seafarers transported in a month at 280, and it was the 3rd highest for the # ships assisted in a month a 18. Thank you to our volunteer Driver/Watch Keepers!

The first cruise ship the Viking Octantis is due tonight. Yesterday I learned that Viking has not engaged a bus to shuttle its crew to shopping, which they did last year, and was asked if the Mission would attend Viking ships. 18 cruise ship visited are scheduled this season, representing 5 different ships.




