The first cruise ship the Viking Octantis is due tonight. Yesterday I learned that Viking has not engaged a bus to shuttle its crew to shopping, which they did last year, and was asked if the Mission would attend Viking ships. 18 cruise ship visits are scheduled this season, representing 5 different ships.

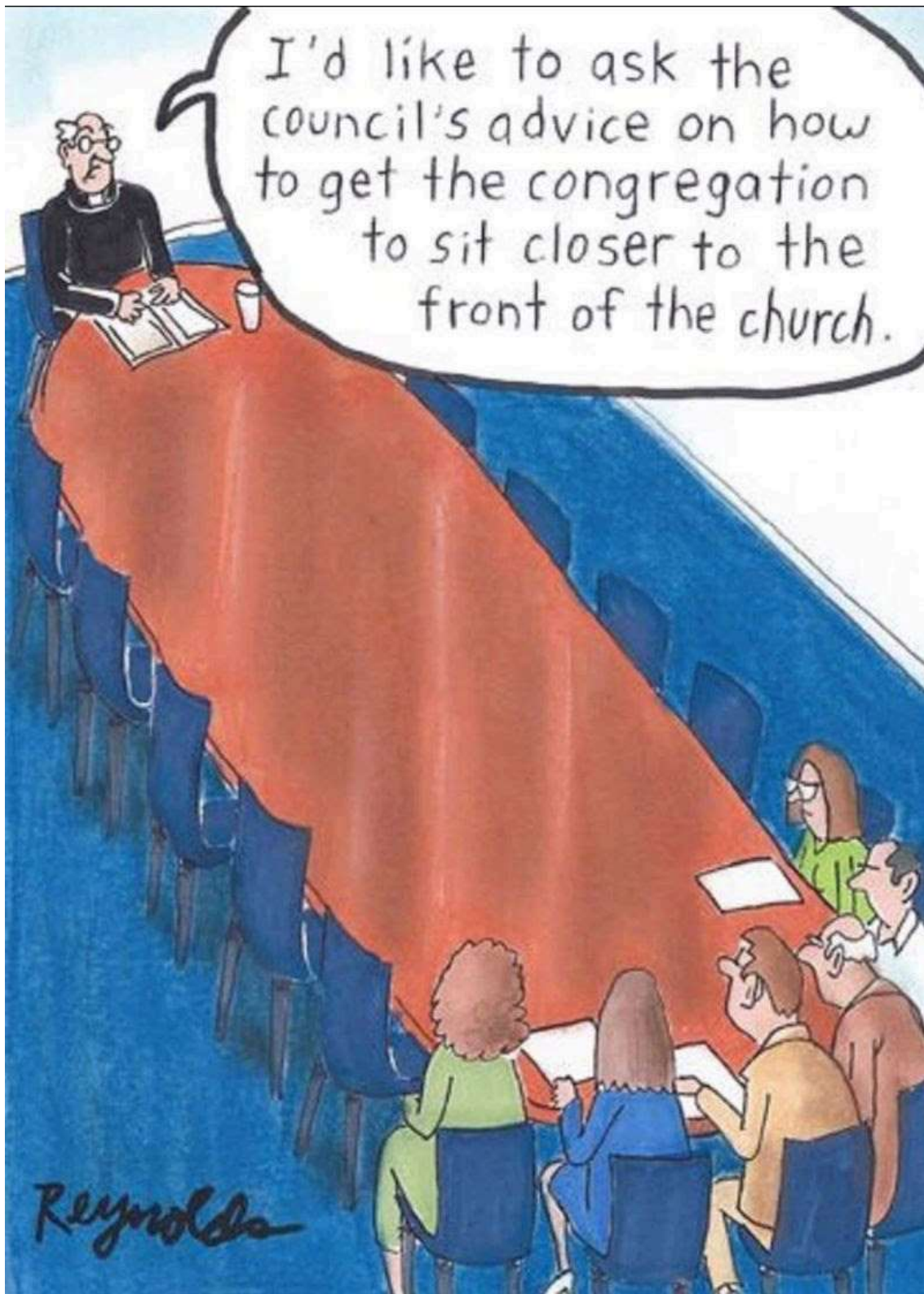
